



BEDSPREAD CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Quilted bedspreads are washable provided that both the face and backing fabrics are marked washable. Shrinkage of 2% - 3% is normal when washing a quilted spread.

As a general guide, the following rules should be followed:

Washing Cycle

Perma-press setting, warm wash, cold rinse with a mild detergent, not to exceed 120 degrees.

Drying Cycle

Perma-press or delicate setting. Cool air only or a maximum temperature of 120 degrees.

Note! Whenever possible, dry cleaning is preferred.
